<b>Big Swamp Preserve:</b> CMNH's newest preserve with 400 acres of forest, buttonbush swamp, swamp wetland complex, rare plants & significant amphibian communities.	Quest 2	
<b>East Harbor State Park:</b> The interface between Lake Erie & inland marshes. Rare coastal species, marsh and meadow flora and more.	Quest 3	
<b>Meadowbrook Marsh/Lakeside Daisy Preserve:</b> inland estuary with aquatic emergent vegetation to prairie woodland species and Alvar habitat rarities.	Quest 4	
<b>ONWR-Further Afield with Insects:</b> dragonflies, damselflies, butterflies and more with species galore. Location for Ohio butterfly rarities.	Quest 5	Trip Filled
<b>ONWR-Botany Latin:</b> Lake Erie wetland botany with wet prairies at the refuge. See the grounds <b>by bus/tram</b> and then explore in depth. Serious botany!	Quest 6	
<b>ONWR-Botany Lite:</b> Same location, home to bald eagles and aquatic & wetland plants. Trip <b>by bus/tram</b> then learn about the role of this refuge and botany.	Quest 7	
<b>Castalia Resthaven Preserve:</b> finest and largest tallgrass prairie and fen complexes in Ohio. Visit several locations to see rare species including small fringed gentian.	Quest 8
